Ash Wednesday:

Lent IV:

He provides food for those who fear Him; He remembers
His covenant forever (Ps. 111:5).

Lent V:

God shows His love for us in that while we were still
sinners, Christ died for us (Rom. 5:8).

Lent VI:

He is the propitiation for our sins and not for ours only,
but also for the sins of the whole world (1 John 2:2).
