In addition to holding your child’s spot, the resource fee is used for computers (maintenance and upgrades), consumable books, safety equipment, and a variety of other consumable necessities. Resource Fees are non-refundable.

**KING’S CLUB (Before/After-School Care for K-8<sup>th</sup> Grade)..... \$5.00/hour**

The school day begins promptly at 8:30 and car pick-up concludes at 3:30. Students dropped off at school before 8:00am and here after 3:30pm will participate in our King’s Club program. There is a \$5.00 minimum charge for the first hour and \$1.25 for each additional quarter hour rounded up to the nearest quarter hour. King’s Club fees are separate from tuition in the K-8<sup>th</sup> Grade program.

## **Tuition**

In order to provide the highest standard of education at Christ Lutheran School, we must collect tuition and fees each year. The following policies are included in the student/parent handbook and guide our tuition collection process.

- The first tuition payment in addition to registration fees is due at registration.
- Tuition payments are due on or before the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month. Alternate dates can be established with administrative approval.
- Tuition can be billed over 10 months or paid in full at the beginning of the year. Other arrangements must be approved by the administration.
- All deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Late payments may be assessed a \$25.00 late fee.
- Returned checks will be assessed a \$20.00 service fee.
- Tuition and fees must be current before a student's records can be transferred.
- Eighth grade students will not be granted a diploma, nor will they be allowed to participate in commencement unless all financial obligations, including tuition, have been met.
- Year-end final report cards and other educational information (including the transfer of student records to other schools) will be withheld until financial obligations have been met.
- Students with accounts in arrears more than 30 days will not be permitted to participate in extra-curricular, school-sponsored activities.
- Services provided through King's Club and Band will be discontinued if payments are over thirty (30) days late.
- In the event of withdrawal or dismissal students leaving Christ Lutheran School will be responsible for tuition and fees through the end of the current school year.
- Prepaid tuition is non-refundable after September 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year.
- Accounts not current by June 15<sup>th</sup> will result in loss of roster place for the following year.
- Non-payment of tuition/fees may result in termination of enrollment.
